- 2- **Standing on Arafat**: The pilgrims go to Mount Arafat (جبل عرفات) on the 9th of Thul-Hijjah.
- 3- **Al-Tawaf**: The pilgrims walk around the Holy Ka'bah seven times.
- 4- **Al-Sa'ay**: The pilgrims hasten between the two hills of Safa (الصفا) and Marwah (المروه) seven times.

The sacrificed animal is divided into three parts, one third for the family, one third to give it Sadaqa to needy people and third can be gifted to friends or neighbours or anybody else .
